

## TRUST AND ESTATE ADMINISTRATION INTERPRETATION OF TERMS

Probate: This is granted after a testator has died and his/her Will is intended to be read and his Estate administered.

- •Executor: One who is appointed by the Testator and responsible for administering the Estate of the Testator upon his death. Could be an individual or a Fiduciary Company.
- •Beneficiary: A person who has been named to benefit from the Estate of the Testator
- Testator: A Person making a Wil:
- Setflor: The person establishing a Trust.
- •IntEstate: Used to describe a situation where a person dies without writing a Will.
- Succession: The process of inheriting a title or property
- •Discretionary: The power of free Will. The power to be able to exercise ones free Will with regards to something
- •Power of Attorney: The authority given to someone granting the person the power to do that which the other person would ordinarily do but is unable to do due to certain circumstances.
